



POLICE NOTICE

Be Careful Not to Be Involved in Mobile Phone Related Crime

Nowadays, more and more people are signing mobile phone contracts prompted by SNS posts that say something like this: "Easy-money making part time job is available. All you have to do is to sign a mobile phone contract!" But mind you.

Signing a mobile phone contract and giving the phone and /or SIM card is **illegal!**

If you do the above-mentioned activities, you can be charged with the following crimes and possibly punished as provided in parentheses below.

- Fraud against a mobile voice communication service carrier (Imprisonment for not more than 10 years)
- Violation of the Act on Identity Confirmation, etc. Performed by Mobile Voice Communications Carriers for their Subscribers, etc. and Prevention of Wrongful Use of Mobile Voice Communications Service (Fine not more than 500,000 JPY, etc.)

Check

To protect yourself from being involved in such criminal activities:

- If someone asks you to sign a mobile phone or a SIM card contract, say no!
- Don't give your mobile phone or SIM card to anyone!

Any part-time job that asks you to sign a mobile phone contract is a crime.

Don't do it!
