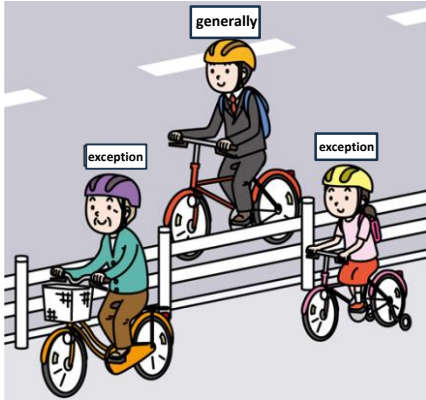
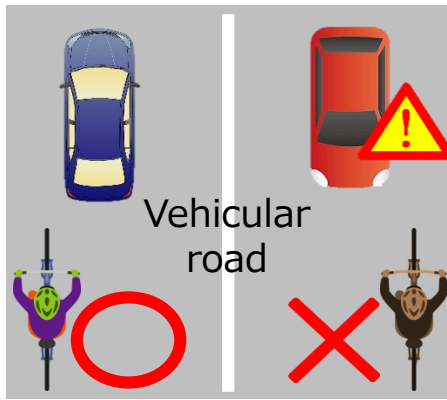


# Five Rules Cyclists Must Follow for Traffic Safety

① Cyclists must ride on the left side of the vehicular road. Riding on sidewalks is prohibited except where permitted, and pedestrians always have the right of way.



Bicycles are vehicles and generally must be ridden on a vehicular road when the sidewalk and the road are separated.



Cyclists must travel on the left side of the vehicular road (On a road without designated traffic lanes, they should keep to the leftmost edge).



When cyclists are permitted to use the sidewalk by the above sign or other signs, they must ride on the side of the sidewalk nearest the vehicular road at a reduced speed.

② When approaching an intersection, obey traffic signals and stop completely before entering, making sure it is safe to proceed.



Following signals is mandatory!

No matter how hurried you are. When the traffic signal begins to flash, do not enter the intersection.



Before entering any intersection, whether or not there is a stop sign, bring your bicycle to a complete stop and check that it is safe before proceeding.

③ Turn on your lights in the evening.

Without lights, you are difficult for others to see, which is very dangerous.

④ Riding a bicycle after drinking is prohibited.

Riding a bicycle after drinking any amount of alcohol is prohibited.

⑤ Wear a helmet properly.



Wear a helmet properly. Both adults and children should wear helmets

- Choose a helmet that matches the size of your head.
- Place the front edge of the helmet just above your eyebrows, keeping it level on your head.
- Adjust the chin strap so that you can insert one to two fingers between the strap and your chin.
